**ORDER**

Whereas an order bearing no. DM/MA/2021/7380, dated: 07.04.2021, an order bearing no. DM/MA/2021/8080, dated: 13.04.2021 and an order bearing no. DM/MA/2021/8846, dated: 23.04.2021 was issued by the office of undersigned whereby corona curfew was imposed in Chandigarh between 09:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. as a measure of isolation and social distancing to contain the spread of COVID-19 due to a lot of non-essential movement of people and vehicles during night.

Whereas, a War Room meeting was held on 28.04.2021 to review the COVID-19 situation. In that meeting, it was decided that timings of corona curfew should be changed to 06:00 P.M. to 05:00 A.M. on all days.

Now, therefore, I, Mandip Singh Brar, I.A.S., District Magistrate, U.T., Chandigarh, in modification of the above mentioned orders, while exercising the power vested with me u/s 144 Cr.P.C. do hereby order that there shall be prohibition on movement of individuals/travellers for all non-essential activities between 06:00 P.M. to 05:00 A.M. in Chandigarh. No person shall leave their homes or shall move on foot or by vehicle or travel or stand or roam around on any road or public places during above said hours.

Following categories shall be exempted:

1. Those tasked with law & order/emergency and municipal services/duties including Executive Magistrates, Police personnel, Military/C.A.P.F. personnel in uniform, health, electricity, fire, media persons with accreditation, telecom services including internet and Government machinery tasked with COVID-19 related duties (all on production of Identity Card).



2. The Manufacturing industry shall be allowed to remain open. The movement of employees/labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them shall be allowed. However, concerned Industry shall issue them requisite permission / Identity cards for the purpose.
3. There shall be no curbs on inter-State movement of essential and non-essential goods.
4. All vehicles/persons in bonafide transit (inter-State) shall be allowed to pass, but only after due verification of point of origin and destination.
5. Hospitals, chemist shops including animal pet shops and A.T.M.s shall be allowed to remain open 24X7.
6. The kitchens of restaurants / eating places, hotels including food joints / courts in various malls can remain open after 6 PM only for Home Delivery up to 9 PM. The restaurant and home delivery staff shall be allowed to move on production of valid ID card issued to them by their respective establishments.
7. Pregnant women and patients for getting medical/health services.
8. Passengers going to or returning from the airport or railway station or I.S.B.T. shall be exempted.
9. Marriages with prior permission of SDM concerned and attendance of up to 50 persons shall be allowed. Funerals/last rites attended by up to 20 persons are allowed.





10. Those specially issued a restricted movement pass by the officers authorized in this behalf. Persons seeking movement pass may contact on 0172-2700076 & 0172-2700341 or apply online on [www.admser.chd.nic.in/dpc](http://www.admser.chd.nic.in/dpc) for a movement pass. Sh. Pardhuman Singh, H.C.S. and Sh. Sanjeev Kohli, R.L.O. will be the Nodal Officers for this purpose.

11. All passes related to the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and District Courts shall be issued by the Registrar General, Punjab & Haryana High Court.



Any breach of this order shall invite action under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 06:00 P.M. on 29.04.2021 and shall remain effective till further orders.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated by affixing copies thereof at the notice boards of the office of the undersigned as well as District Courts and publication in the newspapers having circulation in the area, through the office of the D.P.R., Chandigarh.
