ORDERS

Imphal, the 28th May, 2021

1. Whereas, the Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 had issued orders dated 17/05/2021 imposing "Curfew" and restricting the activities to only few essential services in the Districts of Imphal West, Imphal East, Bishnupur, Thoubal, Kakching, Churachandpur and Ukhrul.
2. Whereas, the number of infections of the Covid-19 virus detected everyday continues to be very high relative to the population and is a source of concern.
3. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 the undersigned in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority, **hereby extends the order of even No. dated 17/05/2021 imposing "CURFEW" in the Districts of Imphal West, Imphal East, Bishnupur, Thoubal, Kakching, Churachandpur and Ukhrul with limited permitted activities and the guidelines including restrictions on inter district movements in respect of the remaining nine districts i.e. Senapati, Kangpokpi, Kamjong, Tengnoupal, Chandel, Pherzawl, Noney, Tamenglong and Jiribam for another 14(fourteen days) till 11/06/2021 with some additional permitted activities as below.**

The list of activities already permitted, and continues to be permitted, is at Annexure.

I. List of additional permitted activities.

- i. All Secretariat offices to start functioning with e-office and physical attendance 15% staff from 01/06/2021.
- ii. All Directorate offices to start functioning with physical attendance 15% staff from 01/06/2021 by taking adequate precaution and strictly following Covid Appropriate Behaviour.
- iii. Departments like Media, Power, Fire Service, PHED, CAFPD, Home, Health, Relief & DM, Forest, Environment & Climate Change, Finance and Treasuries and Police departments and District Administration will continue to function as before.
- iv. Vehicle workshops of goods trucks, Petrol tankers, LPG bullets etc outside the Imphal municipal area may open from 8 am to 3 pm on all days taking adequate precaution and strictly following Covid Appropriate Behaviour.
- v. Rice mills are also allowed to open subject to taking adequate precaution and strictly following Covid Appropriate Behaviour.
- vi. **Opening of local vegetable vendors from 7 am to 10 am for purchase by the locals on 30/05/2021, 02/06/2021, 05/06/2021 and 08/06/2021.** The vegetable vendors should be seated at least 6 feet away from one another and should wear mask all the time.
- vii. Only one out of three grocery shops of the total shops/vendors in one location shall be allowed to open on rotational basis from **7 am to 10 am on 30/05/2021, 02/06/2021, 05/06/2021 and 08/06/2021.** If the shops or vendors are located in congested rows (on major roads like NH both sides may open), then only alternate rows shall be allowed to open. Queue system should be adopted by all shops and vendors.





I. List of activities already permitted vide order dated 17/05/2021.

- i. All healthcare facilities, including animal healthcare, hospitals, clinics, nursing homes and movement of healthcare workers.
- ii. All pharmacies, including those selling veterinary medicines.
- iii. All persons going for COVID-19 vaccination, COVID testing and medical emergencies are exempted.
- iv. All employees and personal staff working in Media, Power, Fire Service, PHED, CAFPD, Home, Health, Relief & DM, Forest, Environment & Climate Change, Finance and Treasuries and Police departments and District Administration are exempted (all other offices to remain closed).
- v. Only goods vehicles including those carrying construction materials, oxygen supply related vehicles, LPG and Oil tankers and vehicles of other essential services like Power supply, water supply, waste/garbage clearance, Public Distribution System, medical/covid services, electronic and print media, internet & telecom service providers and vehicles of personnel of departments/ organizations permitted to be functional.
- vi. Opening of Petrol pumps and LPG outlets and movement of staff of IOCL will continue to be permitted.
- vii. Imphal airport shall remain open and movement of staff and passengers will continue to be permitted.
- viii. Hotels for lodging will be allowed to remain open with minimum staff. Restaurants to remain closed.
- ix. Child Protection Services (Orphanages, Children Homes, Observation Homes, etc)
- x. Home delivery services under ICDS/ICPS (supplementary nutrition for children, pregnant & lactating mothers).
- xi. Home delivery of various goods and services (food items, vegetables, groceries, medicines, etc) including e-commerce platforms.
- xii. Banking services with limited staff on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10.00 AM to 2:30 PM for urgent Government and non-government transactions only.
- xiii. ATM services including refilling of cash in ATMs are allowed.
- xiv. Sale of fish feed, animal feed, milk and milk products, fish, poultry and poultry products from 7 Am to 2 PM for purchase by locals.
- xv. **Postal services with** limited staff on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10.00 AM to 2:30 PM dispose time bound works including delivery of medicines and medical equipment.

II. Restrictions vide order dated 17/05/2021.

- i. Strict ban on vehicular movement continues even during 7 am to 10 am.
- ii. Three Ima Keithels, its adjoining markets and the local markets of Local markets at Khurai Lamlong, Andro Parking, Lambulane, Kongba, Pishum thong, Kwakeithel, Nagamapal, Singjamei Bazaar, Wahengbam Leikai and major other major markets in other districts shall remain closed.
